



## **The Moat Way: Marking and Feedback**

Below are the key elements of The Moat Way for marking and feedback:

- All assessed pieces of work must be kept either in an assessment book and/or folder, or explicitly labelled
- Assessments should be marked with grades and feedback given to students on how to improve
- There must be specific opportunities given to students so that they can respond to feedback
- Every ten lessons, or every three weeks (whichever comes first), there must be effective feedback given, with developmental targets, which enables students to move forward in their learning
- There should be a specific literacy target for each assessed piece of work
- Teachers must set regular assessments in line with department policies
- Teachers must refuse to accept work that has been produced with inadequate effort; students must re-do substandard work
- Homework must be set regularly. It needs to be clearly labelled and dated. It must be marked regularly
- All assessment marks must be recorded on Go4schools
